Millions of kids throughout the world find themselves surviving or living on the streets. Many of them struggle each day for the basic needs of life--food, clothing and shelter.

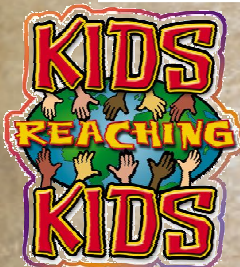
