

# World Quiz 2017—Frequently Asked Questions . . .

**Q:** Are all children eligible for World Quiz?

**A:** Only children who have completed grades 1-6, who qualify at the final District Quiz will be eligible to attend World Quiz.

**Q:** How many quizzers will be at World Quiz?

**A:** There will be over 2,000 children quizzing at World Quiz.

**Q:** What must my child do to qualify for World Quiz?

**A:** Your child must score 80% or better on the 2 “Qualifying Rounds” at the final District Quiz meet. For red level, your child can miss no more than 6 questions; for blue level, your child can miss no more than 8 questions.

**Q:** What will my child be quizzing over at the final District Quiz?

**A:** The final District Quiz will cover Dig Sites 1-20. Your child will need to recall information from the entire quizzing year.

**Q:** If my child qualifies, is he/she required to attend World Quiz?

**A:** There is no requirement for anyone to attend World Quiz. However, World Quiz is an experience your child will remember for years to come, so you are encouraged to make every effort to attend if he/she qualifies.

**Q:** If my child does not qualify for World Quiz this year, will he/she have another opportunity to participate?

**A:** World Quiz is held every four years in conjunction with General Assembly and Conventions. Therefore, if your child is in first or second grade this year, they will have another opportunity to qualify in 2021. However, if your child is third grade or older, this is his/her last opportunity to qualify for and attend World Quiz.

**Q:** How many different countries will be represented at World Quiz?

**A:** All countries are invited, but USA/Canada will most likely be the only ones that are able to attend the quiz. There will be quizzes held around the world on the same weekend to accommodate those who cannot travel to the US for the quiz.

**Q:** When and where is World Quiz? When do I need to arrive?

**A:** World Quiz is on Saturday, June 24, 2017, in Indianapolis, IN. Red level begins at 8:00 a.m. and Blue level begins at 12:00 pm. Children should be seated 15 min. before start time. Check-in will be open Wednesday, June 21, Thursday, June 22, and Friday, June 23, from 8:00 a.m.—10:00 p.m. Please plan to arrive no later than Friday, June 23, 2017. Check-in is not open on Saturday. You are encouraged to make plans to stay for the Saturday, 7:00 p.m. General Assembly service emphasizing children as well as the Sunday morning service. It will be an experience you will never forget. There are many things to experience at General Assembly and Conventions throughout the week leading up to World Quiz.
