

Missionary Health Care funds are provided through four sources:

Gifts From the Heart

- Honoring/memorializing friends and loved ones for:
- ✓ Special events, such as promotions, new arrivals, retirements
- ✓ Special days, such as anniversaries, birthdays, Pastor Appreciation Sunday
- ✓ In lieu of flowers or other memorials (a gift of \$50 or more automatically adds the person's name to the Memorial Roll—see below)
- ✓ Just because...
- Presented by a church, a group, or an individual
- Cost—amount determined by the donor
- Cards and envelopes available in English and Spanish in your church's display rack

Memorial Roll

- Memorializing a deceased loved one, church member, or—as a form of outreach—member of the community
- Presented by a local church, a group, or an individual
- Cost—\$50 each (duplicate certificates for the same person are \$25 each)
- Children's Memorial Roll—for youth 18 and under—available now! Same costs (original and reprints) as certificate for adults

Distinguished Service Award

- Honoring church people who are living—for a particular area of service
- Presented by a church or a group within the church
- Cost—\$100 each
